Progress In Education Donates Computer Systems and Science Lab Materials Worth \$35,000

ACCRA, GHANA. Progress in Education, Inc., (PIE.) has donated computer systems and science lab materials worth approximately \$35,000 to twenty two secondary schools in Ghana. The donated computer systems include 101 sets of computer processing units and LCD monitors, printers and toners. The science laboratory materials include solar energy science kits, prisms, thermometers, stop watches, goggles, beakers, and other glass ware. Several text and reading books are also included in the donation. Over the past two years, PIE has donated nearly \$90,000 worth of computer systems, science lab materials and books to secondary schools in Ghana.
